The Government of India's most challenging reform – introduction of the Goods & Service Tax has been launched with much fanfare and is effective from 1st July 2017. The first two weeks since the launch has been quite smooth. However, the success of this reform would be measured only when the benefit of the tax credit by way of reduction in prices will be eventually passed on the recipients.

To oversee that this benefit is passed on and does not result in any undue profiteering by the business, necessary provisions have been provided for in section 171 of the Central Goods & Services Tax Act and the necessary authority has already been constituted by the Government.

To understand the implementation of these provisions, the Society has organised a lecture meeting on this topic wherein CA. Gautam B. Doshi will take us through the provisions.
