## Relaunch of Project Chalo English Sikhaye...



1. The BCA Foundation (BCAF) is pleased to relaunch "Chalo English Sikhayein" project for the benefit of underprivileged children from vernacular Medium School, in association with Dhrama Bharati Mission (DBM India). The Members & their Family / friends/ Relatives are invited to volunteer in this noble task of making a positive difference to the lives of students.

### The salient features of the project are as follows:

2. This project is carried out in the vernacular schools of Mumbai. The Volunteers teach in these schools mostly on Saturdays.
3. However, At present, due to Covid & Lockdown, these sessions will be online. The teaching would be on a "Google Meet" platform. The medium will be through a Tablet and/or a Smart Phone.
4. Two Volunteers teach a batch of 10 to 14 students for duration of 2 hours. Volunteers can teach one on one or take group/ batch wise classes.
5. In all 12 such sessions are to be conducted. The duration of each session will be for one hour. Minimum hours of Commitment by a Volunteer are 12 hours.
6. The 1st Session is about introduction and icebreaking and the last session is for Summarising and mentorship.
7. The sessions will be as per the Printed Module which encourages children to think and talk and make correct conversation sentences.(Experts in the field were consulted and have contributed to make this Module, which is time tested and people tested).
8. At present Volunteers can teach Maths and Science as well, as these are in great demand.
9. Volunteers are requested to share their preferred time slots, their preferences of teaching, skills (example, English/Maths/Science), and preferred days. The organising team will match them to the students accordingly.
10. The students will be from class 7 and 8 only, as students from class 9 and 10 are now attending schools.
11. Volunteers are requested to share their preferred time slots, their preferences of teaching, skills (example, English/Maths/Science), and preferred days. The organising team will match them to the students accordingly.
12. The students will be from class 7 and 8 only, as students from class 9 and 10 are now attending schools.
13. Emphasis should be on rapport building and encouraging students to talk confidently.
14. A DBM Coordinator will be assisting to monitor the smooth working of the online project.
