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MEMBERSHIP TERMS AND BENEFITS

Membership to the Bombay Chartered Accountants' Society (BCAS) was hitherto open only to Chartered Accountants in their individual capacity. There was a growing demand from corporate houses to open the membership for the chartered accountants engaged in their organization. In response to that BCAS has now opened a new membership category called Corporate Membership.

Who is eligible to become a Corporate Member?

This membership is open for the following entities:

- Public or Private Limited Companies
- Limited Liabilities Partnership Firms (Excluding CAs firms)

How many persons can a Corporate Member nominate?

This membership entitles you to nominate two persons from your organization as part of the base membership. Of course you may nominate more persons at an additional charge as mentioned hereinunder. The only condition being that all persons nominated by you should be a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

What are the benefits of becoming a Corporate Member?

1. You can nominate as many Chartered Accountants from your organization as you desire subject to payment of the requisite fees. Such persons shall become Associate Members.
2. A single membership for the entire group of Chartered Accountants within your organization with the flexibility to change nominations as per the change within your organization.
3. All the nominated members will enjoy the same benefits as an Ordinary Member of the BCAS. (And there are a lot of them as can be seen in the attached brochure)
4. The only difference being that neither the Corporate Member nor the nominated members are eligible to:
 - a. Contest any election of the BCAS and
 - b. Vote at any election at the AGM or an extraordinary general meeting.

What are the benefits of Corporate Membership to the Associate Members?

1. You get timely information of all of BCAS programmes, publications from which you can choose those of your interest. BCAS conducts a host of lectures, seminars, conferences, workshops, residential/non-residential refresher courses, long-duration advanced programmes, Study Circles, etc.
2. Terrific opportunities to network with fellow chartered accountants and visiting dignitaries and experts.

What are the fees for Corporate Membership?

- Entrance Fees — Rs. 5,700/-*
- 3-year membership fees for nominating two associate members — Rs. 11,400/-*
- Any additional associate members for 3 years — Rs. 6,840/-* per member
